It gives us immense pleasure to inform you that the school is organizing a High Altitude Trekking Expedition to Dzungri (13,200 ft.) in Sikkim Himalayas from 8th to 15th March 2015 for the Boys of Class XI only. Details for the same may be read as under:

- The tour is subject to minimum confirmation of 12 students and maximum no. should not exceed 20. Selection will be on first come first serve basis.
Students suffering from asthma or high altitude sickness are advised not to join the trekking team.
Physical fitness of students is mandatory and they are advised to do the regular jogging for at least 15 days prior to departure.
Escort teacher along with experienced mountaineer will accompany the team.

Interested parents may kindly submit the consent form along with a copy of passport size photograph of their ward to the tour coordinator and also deposit an amount of Rs.14,000/- (non refundable; which includes traveling cost, all meals, entry fee, guide fee, equipments fee, etc.) in the school accounts department on or before 30th January 2015.
Excess amount (if any) shall be refunded back from the school accounts department as per refund policy.
